## Scholarship Application Policies & Procedures

### DEADLINES

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS SHOULD BE SUBMITTED AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE.

Although awards will not be made until March, decisions between two equally qualified candidates will be based on application date.

**March 31** is the school's early registration deadline.

ALL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST HAVE SUBMITTED THEIR REGISTRATION AND PAID THEIR FULL DEPOSIT BY THAT DATE. If attendance is dependent on a scholarship award, the minimum award needed to attend should be noted on the application. If the student is not awarded a scholarship in at least that amount, the application will be withdrawn and the deposit refunded.

**June 15** is the school's payment deadline.

ALL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST HAVE PAID ANY OUTSTANDING BALANCES BY THAT DATE.

**ANY AWARD WILL IMMEDIATELY BE WITHDRAWN IF EITHER DEADLINE IS MISSED.**

ALL SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS MUST BE WEEK 1 RESIDENT PARTICIPANTS.

### APPLICATION

Here is the simple procedure to apply for a scholarship to the Week 1 Summer Session of The Jink & Diddle School of Scottish Fiddling.

- Applicants should write to the Scholarship Committee (e-mail to [jinkdiddle@aol.com](mailto:jinkdiddle@aol.com) is fine) describing:
  1. their musical background/experience
  2. their interest in Scottish Fiddling
  3. what they would hope to achieve by attending the Summer School.
- Have a teacher, mentor or sponsor send a letter of recommendation on their behalf.
- Applicants may voluntarily supply need-based data to strengthen their application – but it is not necessary to do so for scholarship consideration.
